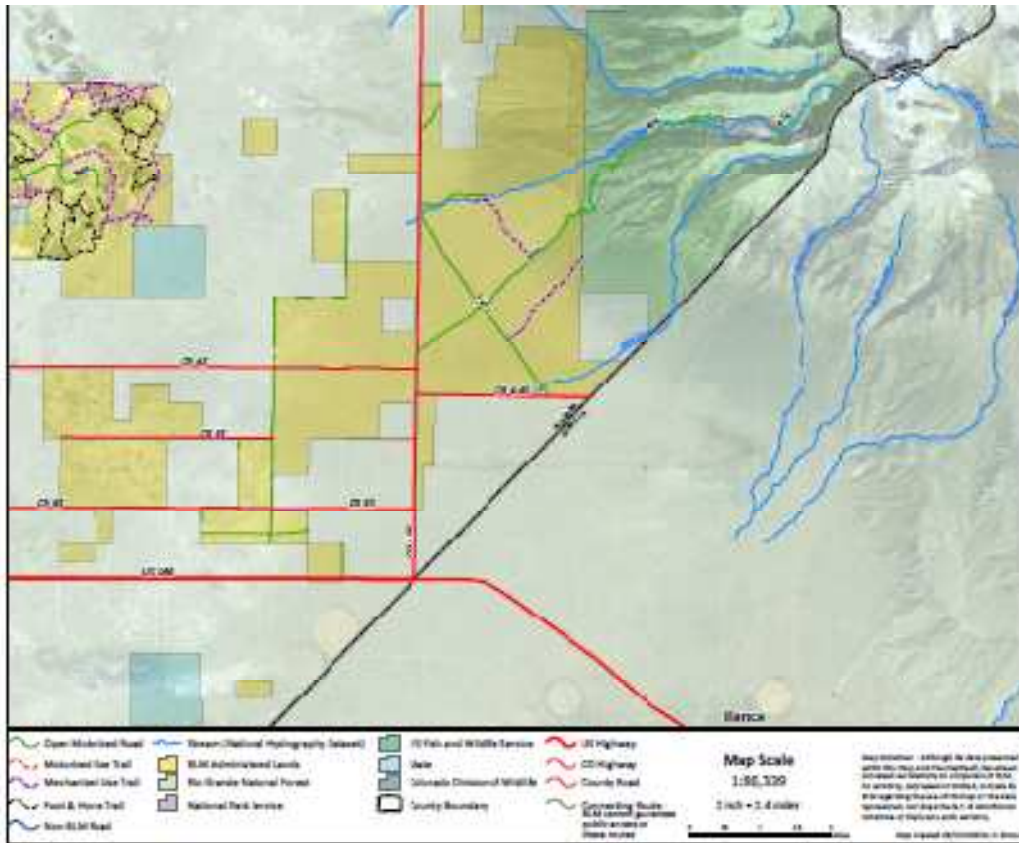

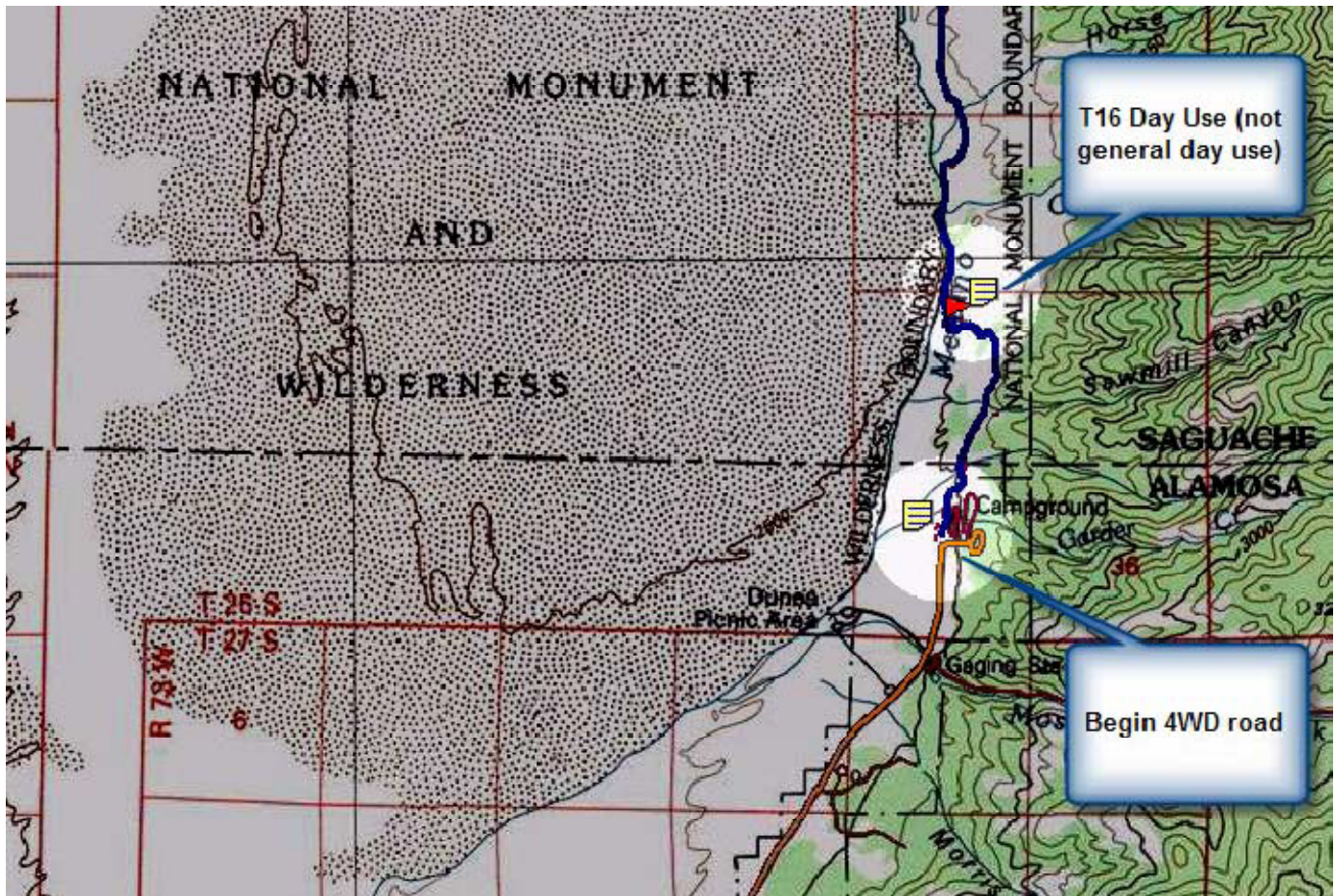
Location

We are camping in dispersed undeveloped BLM land 13 miles south of the park.

Weather

Historic weather averages show highs in the 50's and lows in the upper 20's during April, however, record temps show highs in the mid-80's and lows in the low-20 degree range. Precipitation is common in the afternoons in this area.

Current weather forecast is for clear skies, with highs in the 60's and lows near freezing. Saturday is predicted to be breezy, with southwest wind between 15 and 20 mph with gusts to 30 mph.

Travel Plan

We will meet at PUMC at 16:00 on Friday. Travel will be by private vehicle. There will be a roll call and vehicle checkout at the church. Cars will be checked in at the parking area and a final roll call will be made at camp before dark. We will be pulling the small troop trailer. As always, Scouts and Adult Leaders will travel in Class A Uniforms to and from the event.

The actual drive time is estimated at 3:45 – 4:00, depending on traffic and rest stops.

Getting There

Below is the preferred route to camp on Friday night.

Starting from S Pine Dr

- 1 Head **south** on **S Pine Dr** toward **S Parker Rd** - go **0.2 mi**
- 2 Take the **1st left** onto **S Parker Rd** - go **1.5 mi**
- 3 Turn **right** at **E Stroh Rd** - go **0.9 mi**
- 4 Turn **left** at **N Crowfoot Valley Rd** - go **6.1 mi**
- 5 Turn **right** at **Founders Pkwy** - go **1.6 mi**
- 6 Merge onto **I-25 S** via the ramp to **Colo Springs** - go **132 mi**
- 7 Take exit **52** for **I-25 S** toward **US-160 W/Walsenburg/Alamosa** - go **0.3 mi**
- 8 Keep **right** at the fork, follow signs for **US-160/I-25 BUS S** and merge onto **I-25 BUS S** - go **2.5 mi**
- 9 Turn **right** at **W 7th St/US-160 W** (signs for **US-160 W**) - go **57.3 mi**
Continue to follow **US-160 W**
- 10 Turn **right** at **CO-150 N** - go **3.2 mi**
- 11 Turn **right** - go **161 ft**

Arriving at Unknown road

Total: **206 mi** - about **3 hours 43 mins**

Rest stops: There are several possible rest stops along the way. Colorado rest stops along I-25 at mile marker 111 (Pueblo) and 74 (Colorado City) are well suited.

Driver cautions: None.

Saturday Travel

On Saturday, we will travel from camp to the Park. Parking will either be at the main parking lot or near Castle Creek picnic area, if we take 4WD vehicles.

1. Head **west** toward CO-150 S 161 ft
2. Turn **right** at CO-150 N 16.2 mi
Destination will be on the left

There is a \$3.00 per vehicle parking fee at the visitor center.

Return Trip

We will pack up and leave camp Sunday morning at approximately 10:30 am. We should arrive back at the church around 2:00 pm. There will be a roll call and car checkout at the parking area. Scouts will need to be checked out at the church before leaving.

Emergency Plan

There is an a first aid station at the visitor center near the entrance to the Great Sand Dunes National Park. Emergency response personnel can be called from their office if necessary. Alamosa Regional Hospital is the closest full service medical facility.

Local Emergency Contact

In the event of an emergency, Karla Abell will be notified and will contact necessary parties.

Evacuation

Radios will be issued to key adult leaders, acting SPL, and group scout leaders. In the event an evacuation becomes necessary, there is one preferred exit route:

- Return to car and travel to Alamosa to contact emergency personnel.

PUMC will be the rendezvous point for all evacuations, unless an alternate site is designated by the Camp Host on Evacuation Orders. Roll call will be taken to ensure the safe return of all boys.
