



## **SCOUT LEADERSHIP POSITIONS – Updated 3.1.10**

### **Veteran Gear Coordinator**

The Veteran Gear Coordinator keeps track of gear that has been donated to the troop, and seeks additional donations to serve the needs of specific scouts. In addition, the VGC periodically surveys the troop adults for gear that they would be willing to allow scouts to borrow for special events (snowshoes, tents, backpacks, canoes, clothing, etc.). They are appointed by the Senior Patrol Leader, with the approval of the Scoutmaster.

Reports to: Camping Coordinator / Adult Quartermaster

Prerequisites: Ideally, at least First Class Scout. The VGC should be compassionate and be willing to assist other less fortunate scouts. The VGC should have access to a computer and be capable of setting up surveys with adult assistance.

Leadership Position requirement for rank advancement: Will be determined at the end of the 6 month term

### **Historian Duties:**

- Sets a good example. Enthusiastically wears the Scout Uniform correctly. Lives by the Scout Oath and Law. Shows Scout spirit.
- Works with SPL to make periodic announcements requesting donations at Troop Meetings.
- Gather donated gear and keep track of it.
- Provides digital tracking of the gear troop adults are willing to let scouts borrow to the Camping Coordinator and Quartermaster.
- Other duties as assigned and appropriate
- Participates in a majority of troop meetings and activities.
