Leave No Trace Coordinator

The Leave No Trace Coordinator is a senior Scout who can instruct younger Scouts in the art and science of Leave No Trace. They can be called upon at any time to teach skills at troop meetings or at campouts, and willingly lead other scouts in police lines. They are appointed by the Senior Patrol Leader, with the approval of the Scoutmaster.

Reports to: SPL

Prerequisites: Minimum Star Scout with 3 years Boy Scouting experience. Must have significant outdoor experience, including high adventure backcountry scouting.

Leadership Position requirement for rank advancement: Will be determined at the end of the 6 month term

Instructor Duties:

- Sets a good example. Enthusiastically wears the Scout Uniform correctly. Lives by the Scout Oath and Law. Shows Scout spirit.
- Coordinates with SPL, Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmasters and Merit Badge Counselors in teaching skills to Scouts or patrols within the Troop – on an as needed basis
- Utilizes Police Lines and other opportunities at campouts to teach the skills.
- Prepares well for any time he is instructing other Scouts
- Acts as a role model for younger Scouts
